The competition topic with the submission requirements was revealed at the start of the contest (Further information can be found on the website). This edition was developed completely online. 1048 students signed up in 511 teams, 332 of them downloaded the competition topic and 168 teams submitted their project correctly and on time.

JURY MEETING AND EVALUATION PROCESS

The jury meetings was organized in three phases from October 14th to 31st. The whole evaluation process was held online. The jurors were given a general folder with all the proposals at the same time as specific indications throughout each phase:

PHASE 0 - GENERAL SELECTION - 168 to 105 PROJECTS

A general selection of 105 projects were organized and categorized according to the solutions students proposed to the given topic.

PHASE 1 - INDIVIDUAL SELECTION - 105 to 41 PROJECTS

Each one of the juries became in charge of evaluating these categories individually. From their given selection, their task for this phase was to pick what they considered the best 14 projects and classify them into two groups:

Group A (best 7 projects) + Group B (second-best 7 projects)

PHASE 2 - FINAL SELECTION - 41 to 11 PROJECTS

All the projects selected during PHASE 1 were reviewed during a group online meeting. Each juror introduced their 14 selected projects to the rest of the members. This caused several debates which helped narrowing the first 41 projects to 21.

Students were asked to innovate, take risks and propose things that would be difficult to do within their university studies. With this in mind as well as originality and representational skills, all the jury members concluded with 11 projects. Each jury then acknowledged their best 3 projects which introduced the discussion about the winners of this edition. The remaining 8 projects automatically got selected as the honorable mentions.

Its simple but effective grid system seems like a first step to make the public interact with the space, it could be interesting to look into further alternatives of the land partition and its relationship between the tactical squares.

Its unique intervention about how to use the space around the Eiffel tower involving an interactive screen gives a futuristic solution which made this project stand from the rest. The jury highlighted the elegance of this scheme. Eliminating the Eiffel tower by adding an unusual pagoda structure and bridging this to the Parisian boulevard appears to be a clever manner of blending the two cultures into one. Reinventing the landmark with a cultural stamp provokes a reactivation of the given context and perhaps some signs of the clash between these two types of architecture are missing.
